AFFIDAVIT OF HEIRSHIP

Instructions

Please use the following guidelines to ensure the Affidavit of Heirship is completed correctly:

- 1. It is recommended that the Affidavit be completed by a disinterested party, someone who will not benefit from the decedent's estate. Examples of a suitable "Affiant" would be an attorney, CPA, a longtime friend, or an aunt, uncle or cousin.
- 2. Once completed, the "Affiant" MUST sign the Affidavit in the presence of a Notary Public.
- 3. The Affidavit MUST be recorded in the county where the wells are located. You will need to contact the County Clerk's office for their recording requirements and fees.
- 4. After receiving the recorded Affidavit of Heirship back from the County Clerk, mail a copy of the <u>recorded</u> Affidavit of Heirship along with a copy of the Certificate of Death to:

*A recorded Affidavit of Heirship is required if there is no Will or if there is a Will but it will not be probated.
